Transfer of Marketing Rights of 5 Long-term Listed Drugs to Tanabe Seiyaku Hanbai

Osaka, Japan, March 7, 2011---Mitsubishi Tanabe Pharma Corporation (President & CEO: Michihiro Tsuchiya) announced today that the Company will transfer the marketing rights of five long-term listed drugs to its consolidated subsidiary, Tanabe Seiyaku Hanbai Co., Ltd. (President: Masaki Yoshimoto), as of April 1, 2011.

The five drugs included in the transfer are: ALEGYSAL (for allergic disorders), AROFUTO (for myotonic diseases), INOLIN and BERACHIN (bronchodilators) and SESDEN (anticonvulsant). These drugs have long been widely used in medical practice.

Since October, 2009, the Company has started transferring its long-term listed drugs to Tanabe Seiyaku Hanbai. In October 2010, three long-listed drugs, including the ASPARA products and ASVERIN, were transferred to Tanabe Seiyaku Hanbai.

Tanabe Seiyaku Hanbai will strive to contribute to patients' health through a stable supply of generic drugs and other affordable drugs.
